Library News

With the whole school learning about the local area, I thought the library news this term could focus on our unit.

So far we have learned:

- Bungwahl means 'the place of the swamp water fern root'
- The Bungwahl fern was a very important food source for our First Nation people.
- After the Worimi people put a fire through the thick growth of fronds, the women went in with their sticks and dug up the roots (rhizomes).
- They ground up the white centre of the rhizome into a flour and made it into a porridge. It was very high in protein.



On Thursday we will visit the Sugarloaf Point Lighthouse, Tram Line Beach Smiths Lake (where there was once a little railway) and Nerani (site of a sawmill and a school)—all places of historic significance to our local area.
